

The Most Holy Trinity (A) 11th June psalter week 2

Thought for the week

God is incapable of loneliness; Father, Son and Spirit, living in relationship, yet God who has no need of our companionship wants to invite us to get to know him better—in fact, more than that—to become part of his life; to live the Mystery. Because the mystery is not like a problem to be solved or a formula to be explained. Rather, it is a relationship about which our knowledge can never be exhausted. Sometimes we will be frustrated or even impatient because God isn't revealing himself quite how we might have wanted; but as we get to know better, so we get to love better. All this takes time. We should get a buzz out of knowing that God wants us to be part of that relationship and we're not in it just for what we can get. This is the essence of our baptism and the life of grace, love and communion which flows from it: the grace of the Son, the love of the Father and the communion of the Holy Spirit.

We have all been baptized into the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, it is the bottom line for all Christians; the qualifying statement for any ecumenical relationships— that we have to be baptized according to a Trinitarian formula, So this is our starting point in the adventure of faith. Eventually, our final goal is that the Trinity will be fully revealed to us; but while we exist in time and space our lives are part of the mystery—and thank God for that! In an age when everything else needs to be dissected, deconstructed and explained—we can live with mystery.
