## Message from Fr Kieron

Jesus gave and gave until he literally had nothing left to give. I am not suggesting that I do that or you do that because then, by definition we will be no good to anyone. However, giving the bare minimum, of our time, of our talents or our money, does not seem to be an adequate response to the call of the Gospel. Look not to the scribes in Sunday's readings, but to the two widows. In the Bible widows are often singled out as those deserving of special care and kindness. They were considered to be what we would describe these days as "vulnerable adults". The widows shown to us by today's readings are dishing out the kindness from the little they have. Their vulnerability is transformed into generosity because generosity is measured not in how much we give, but how much we have left afterwards.
